## Guest Speaker Bio

### David Fernandez

David Fernandez is J.P. Morgan's Managing Director and Head of Emerging Asia Research team, covering economics, FX, local rates and sovereign credit. Before joining J.P. Morgan in January 1998, Mr Fernandez spent five years as a professor of economics at the Johns Hopkins University International Studies School where he taught international macroeconomics and was named the Professor of the Year in 1996. Earlier, he served as an Economist in the Council of Economic Advisers in the administration of US President George Bush. In 1987, he joined the Federal Reserve Bank of New York in its OECD economic research department and in the foreign exchange intervention group. Mr Fernandez has a BA in Economics from the University of Pennsylvania and received a Doctorate in Economics from Princeton University where, as a National Science Foundation fellow, he wrote his dissertation under Ben S. Bernanke. In addition to his work at J.P. Morgan, Mr Fernandez is on the advisory board of Singapore Management University's School of Economics.
