Michael is Chief Asia Pacific Economist at Goldman Sachs, responsible for coverage of China, India, ASEAN and the rest of the Asian region excluding Japan.

Prior to this, he was co-director of Global Macro and Markets Research in the London office, responsible for research on global thematic issues and the world economy and sat with the Proprietary Trading Desk. Mike joined Goldman Sachs in 2000, covering Turkey, the exotics and other emerging market issues and was named Managing Director in 2007.

Prior to joining Goldman Sachs, Mike was an economist at the Washington, DC, office of the International Monetary Fund (IMF) for seven years. He took a year of absence from the IMF, from 1997 to 1998, to sail full time on the pre-Olympic sailing circuit, and lectured in politics, philosophy and economics at Jesus College, Oxford University, from 1991 to 1993. He was also a Rhodes Scholar and graduated from Oxford University with an M.Phil in Economics.
