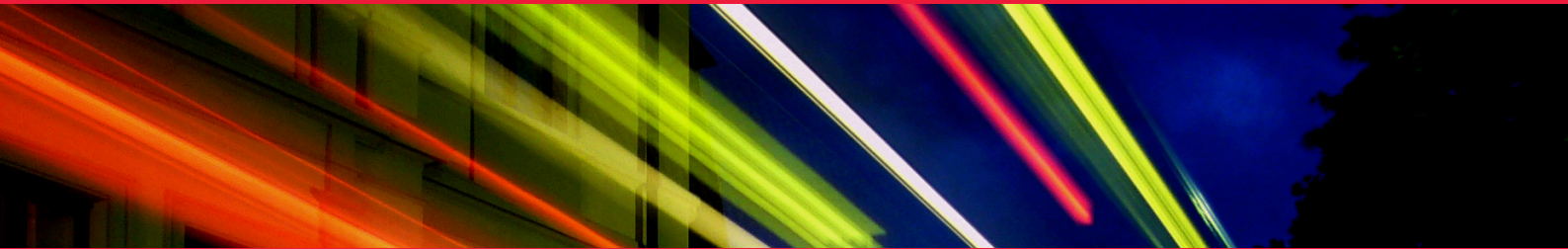


Improving business performance through **effective leadership development**

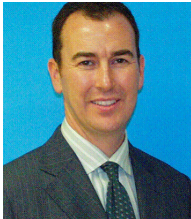
